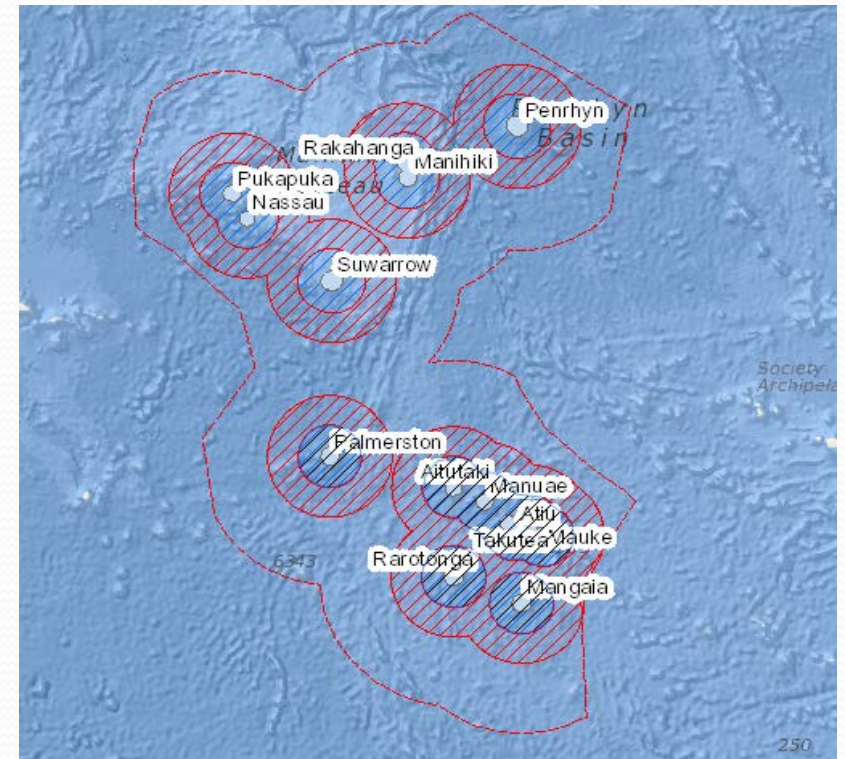


DEFINING AREAS OF PROTECTION WITHIN 2 MILLION SQ/KM'S OF OCEAN

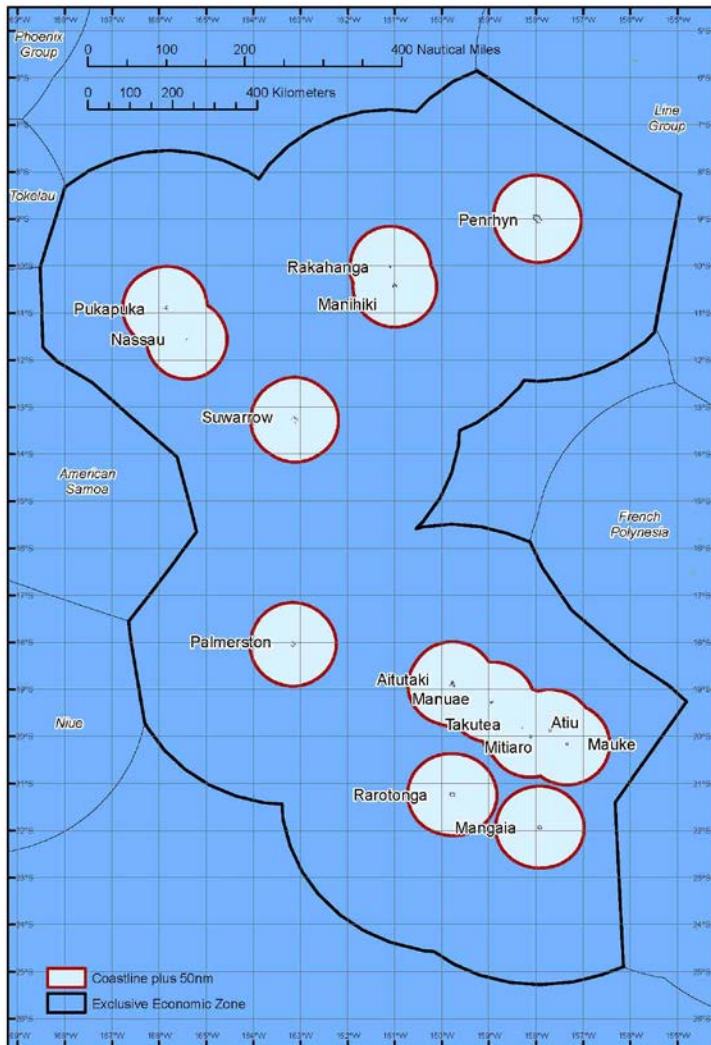

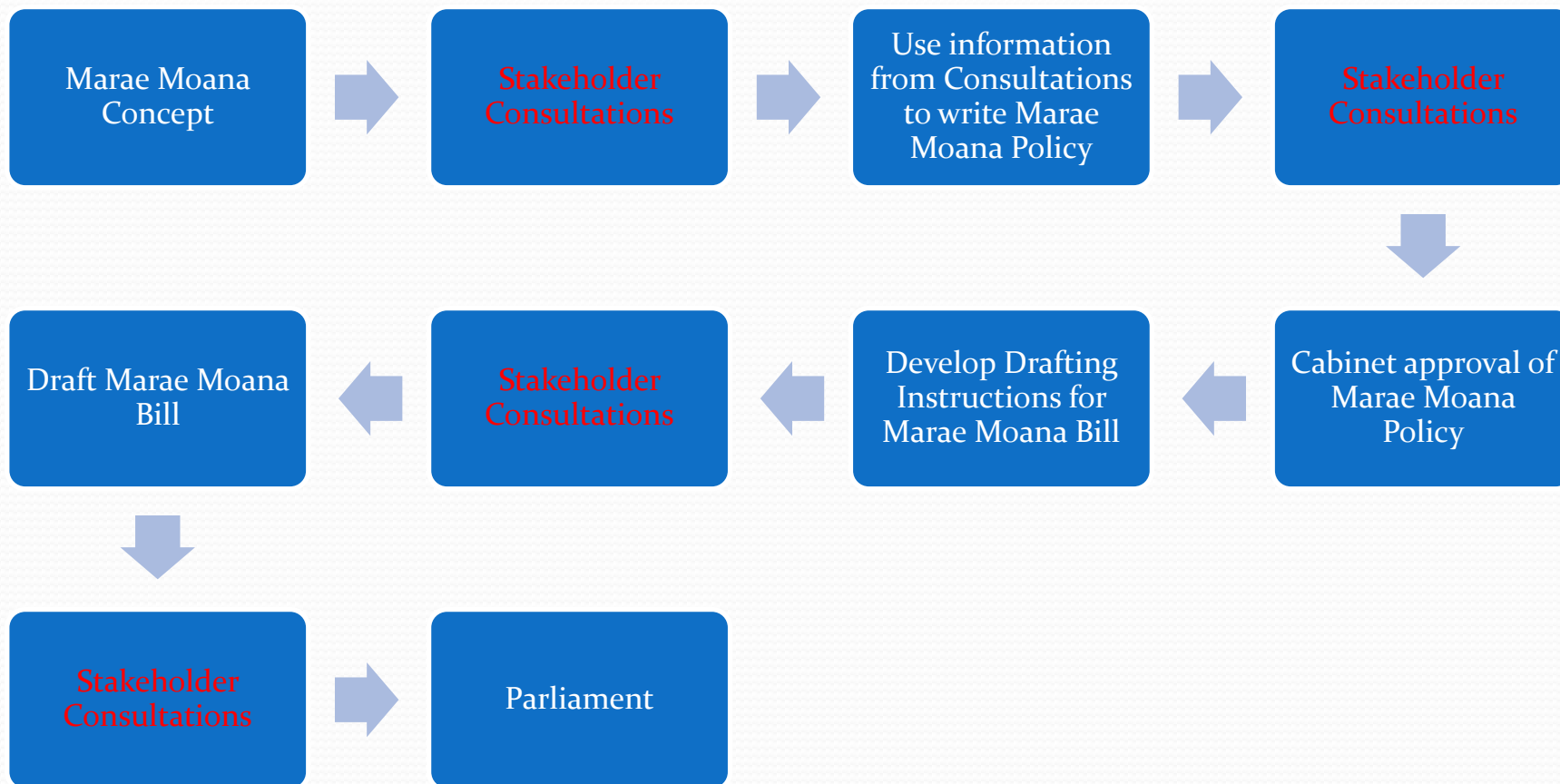


LEGISLATING MARAE MAONA – EXCLUSION ZONES



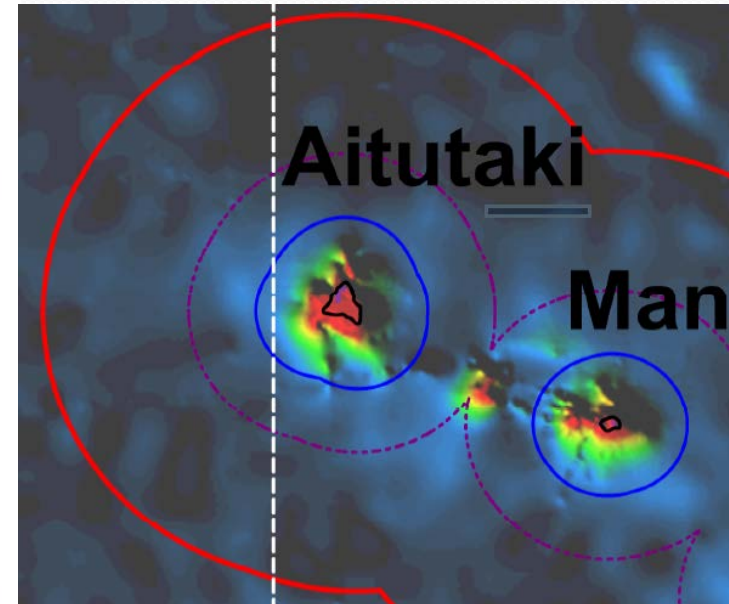
In July 2017, the government of the Cook Islands passed the Marae Moana bill, designating 50 nautical mile exclusion zones around each of its 15 islands. The total area under this protection equates to 324,000 square kilometres, or 16% of the total EEZ (*Aichi Target 11*)

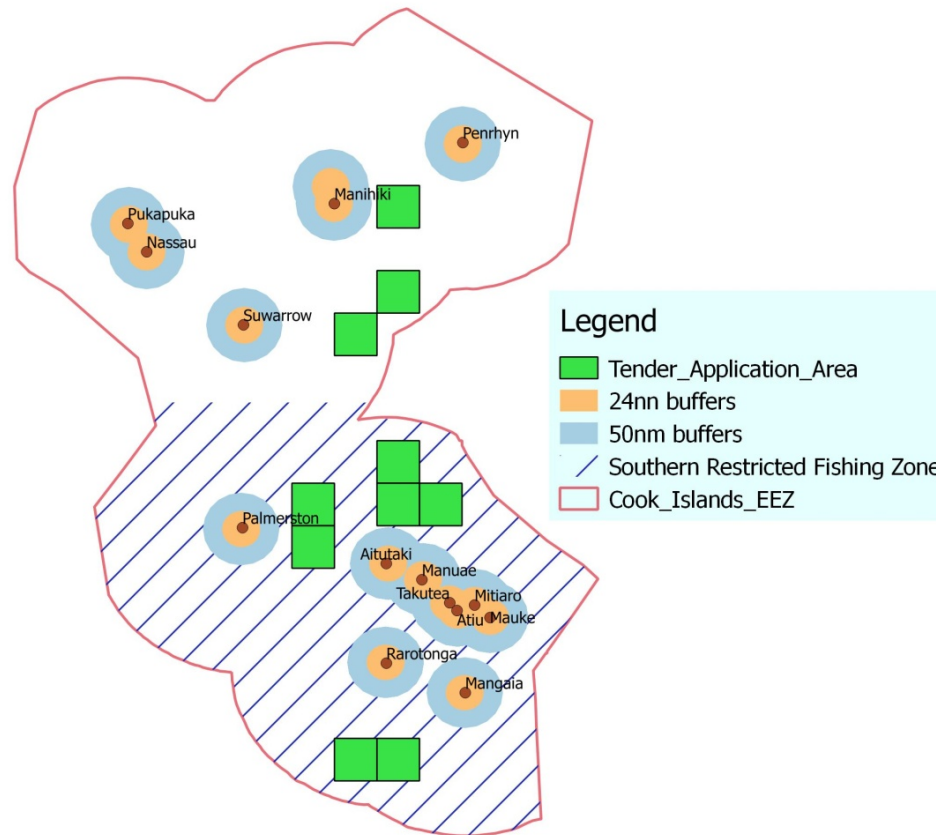
