

## Protected Area Management Effectiveness Workshop 25-27 June, 2018 Castries, Saint Lucia

The Biodiversity and Protected Areas Management Programme (BIOPAMA) aims to improve the long-term conservation and sustainable use of natural resources in African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) countries, in protected areas and surrounding communities. It is an initiative of the ACP Group of States financed by the European Union's 11<sup>th</sup> European Development Fund (EDF), jointly implemented in the Caribbean by the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN), the Joint Research Centre of the European Commission (JRC) and the University of the West Indies. In support of this aim, BIOPAMA is hosting a regional workshop in the Caribbean on protected area management effectiveness (PAME).

### General Objective

Document and promote the implementation of protected area management effectiveness in primarily, the 15 BIOPAMA Caribbean countries<sup>1</sup>.

### Specific Objectives

- a. Introduce the protected area management effectiveness framework, the tools and their implementation in the Caribbean.
- b. Discuss opportunities to promote the implementation of management effectiveness in the protected areas of primarily, the 15 BIOPAMA Caribbean countries.
- c. Introduce the Green List of Protected Areas Standard and its implementation i.e. Standard, Expert Assessment Group (EAGL), adaptation of indicators, etc.
- d. Discuss opportunities to identify pilot cases for the implementation of management effectiveness and the Green List.
